Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

5/8 yard 9570-45 Jot Dot - Gold
 5/8 yard 9570-55 Jot Dot - Purple
 5/8 yard 9570-72 Jot Dot - Cornflower
 5/8 yard 9570-77 Jot Dot - Dk. Blue
 5/8 yard 9570-88 Jot Dot - Red
 3/4 yard 2471-77 Argyle - Navy
 3/4 yard 2472-88 Spiral Hexagons - Red
 3/4 yard 2473-99 Dots - Black
 3/4 yard 2475-88 Irregular Stripes - Red
 3/4 yard 2476-44 Tetris Geo - Mustard
 1-1/8 yards 9570-76 Jot Dot - Teal
 1-1/8 yards 2470-55 Circles - Purple
 4 yards 9570-09 Jot Dot - Marshmallow
 5-5/8 yards 2473-67 Dots - Teal for backing
 85" x 98" piece of Air Lite® Colour Me 100% Cotton batting

Cut Fabrics

Note: All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise indicated.

From each:

9570-45 Jot Dot – Gold
 9570-55 Jot Dot – Purple
 9570-72 Jot Dot - Cornflower
 9570-77 Jot Dot - Dk. Blue
 9570-88 Jot Dot – Red
 *Cut three 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut forty-eight 2" **D2** squares.
 *Cut three 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut forty-eight 2" x 3-1/2" **A1** strips.

From each:

2471-77 Argyle – Navy
 2472-88 Spiral Hexagons – Red
 2473-99 Dots - Black
 2475-88 Irregular Stripes - Red
 2476-44 Tetris Geo – Mustard
 *Cut seven 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut 144 2" **D1** squares.
 *Cut three 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut thirty **C** squares.

From 9570-76 Jot Dot – Teal:

*Cut seven 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut 120 **D3** squares and twenty 2" cornerstone squares.

*Cut nine 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.

From 2470-55 Circles – Purple:

*Cut eight 4-1/2" x WOF strips for border 2.

From 9570-09 Jot Dot – Marshmallow:

*Cut fifteen 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut 240 2" **D** squares and seven 2" x 12-1/2" sashing strips.

*Cut twelve 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut 240 2" x 3-1/2" **A** strips.

*Cut six 5" x WOF strips. Sub-cut 120 2" x 5" **B** strips.

*Cut two 12-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut forty-two 2" x 12-1/2" sashing strips (for a total of 49).

*Cut eight 1-1/2" x WOF strips for border 1.

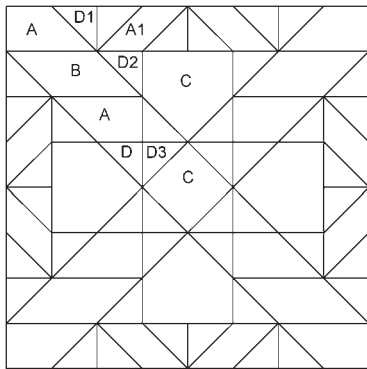
Assemble Blocks

Notes:

- Measurements include 1/4" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated. If no direction is specified, press the seam toward the darker fabric.
- The following are the block colorways (Table 1). **Group fabrics by block for ease of construction.**

Block	Main and Accent Colors	Make
All Blocks	Main: 9570-09 Jot Dot – Marshmallow Accent: 9570-76 Jot Dot - Teal	
1	Accents: 2476-44 Tetris Geo - Mustard 9570-77 Jot Dot - Dk. Blue	6
2	Accents: 2473-99 Dots - Black 9570-55 Jot Dot - Purple	6
3	Accents: 2475-88 Irregular Stripes – Red 9570-45 Jot Dot - Gold	6
4	Accents: 2472-88 Spiral Hexagons - Red 9570-72 Jot Dot - Cornflower	6
5	Accents: 2471-77 Argyle - Navy 9570-88 Jot Dot - Red	6

Table 1. Block colorways.



Block Diagram – Block 1 is depicted below.

Note: Divide the **A** and **B** Marshmallow strips and the **A1** strips of each fabric into two equal groups – left and right – as the **D1** and **D2** squares will be stitched in different positions for each group.

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the **D1** squares. With right sides together, place one marked **D1** square on the right corner of one 9570-09 Jot Dot – Marshmallow **A** strip from the “Right Group” and stitch on the drawn line. Trim seam allowances to $\frac{1}{4}$ ” and press open. Make sixty assorted units. Repeat with thirty more **D1** squares and the Marshmallow **A** strips from the “Left Group,” noting the stitching line direction - **D1** square is stitched to the left corner (*figure 1*).

2. Repeat Step 1 with thirty more Marshmallow **A** strips and the **D2** squares to make sixty units of each type (*figure 2*).

3. Similarly, noting the direction of the stitching line, sew a **D1** square (marked in Step 1) to one corner of the **B** strips in one group, and sew a marked **D2** square to the other corner. Repeat to make sixty units. Repeat this step with the **B** strips of the other group,

sewing the **D1** and **D2** squares differently, as shown below (*figure 3*).

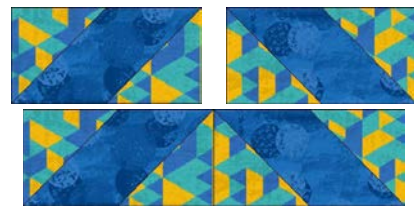


Figure 4 – Make 120.

4. Finally, sew the **D1** squares to the **A1** strips to make 120 strips of each type (*figure 4*). Sew together one unit of each type to make 120 assorted 2” x 6-1/2” strips. Press the seams open.

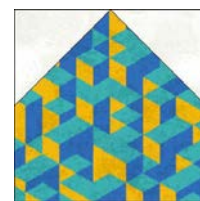


Figure 5 – Make 120 assorted.

5. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 9570-09 Jot Dot – Marshmallow **D** squares. With right sides together, place one marked **D** square on a corner of one **C** square and stitch on the drawn line. Repeat with the adjacent corner of the same square. Trim seam allowances to $\frac{1}{4}$ ” and press open (*figure 5*). Make 120 3-1/2” assorted units.

6. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 9570-76 Jot Dot - Teal **D3** squares. With right sides together, place one marked **D3** square on a corner of one **C** square and stitch on the drawn line. Repeat with the opposite corner of the same square. Trim seam allowances to $\frac{1}{4}$ ” and press open. Repeat with the other corners (*figure 6, next page*). Make thirty assorted 3-1/2” units.

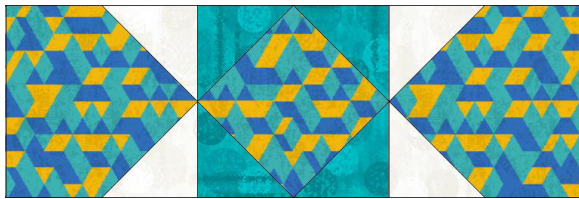


Figure 7 – Make 30 assorted.

7. Sew a Step 5 unit to opposite sides of a Step 6 unit (*figure 7*). Press the seams open. Repeat to make thirty assorted units.

8. Noting fabric orientation, sew a Step 2 unit to opposite sides of a Step 5 unit (*figure 8*). Press the seams open. Repeat to make sixty assorted units.

9. Sew a Step 4 strip to the dark side of the Step 8 units, as shown on the diagram below (*figure 9*). Press the seams in one direction.

10. Noting fabric orientation, sew a Step 3 unit to opposite sides of the Step 9 units (*figure 10*). Press the seams in one direction.

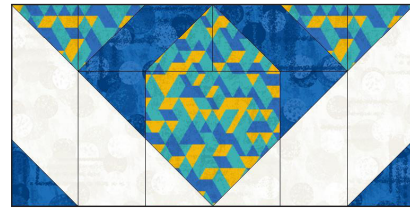

11. Sew a Step 10 unit to opposite sides of the Step 7 units (*figure 11*). Press the seams open.

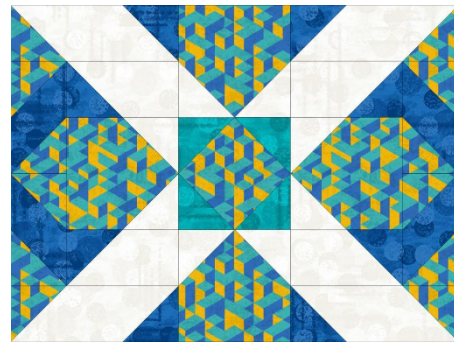

12. Noting fabric orientation, sew a Step 1 unit to the right and one to the left of the remaining Step 4 units to make sixty rows. Sew one row to the top and one to the bottom of the Step 11 units (*figure 12*). Press the seams in one direction. Make thirty assorted 12-1/2" blocks.

Assemble Quilt Top

13. Referring to the quilt photo for block placement, lay out five blocks and four 2" x 12-1/2" 9570-09 Jot Dot – Marshmallow sashing strips in six rows, and join the blocks and sashing strips together in each row. Press the seams toward the sashing.

14. To make the horizontal sashing rows, sew together five Marshmallow sashing strips and four 2" 9570-76 Jot Dot – Teal cornerstone squares. Repeat to make a total of five sashing strips. Press the seams toward the sashing.

15. Matching adjacent seams, sew block rows and horizontal sashing strips together. Press the seams in one direction.

16. For border 1, join the eight 1-1/2" 9570-09 Jot Dot – Marshmallow strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and cut two border strips that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top and press the seams toward the border strips. Measure

the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut two border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.

17. Repeat Step 16 with the eight 4-1/2" 2470-55 Circles - Purple strips to make and add border 2.

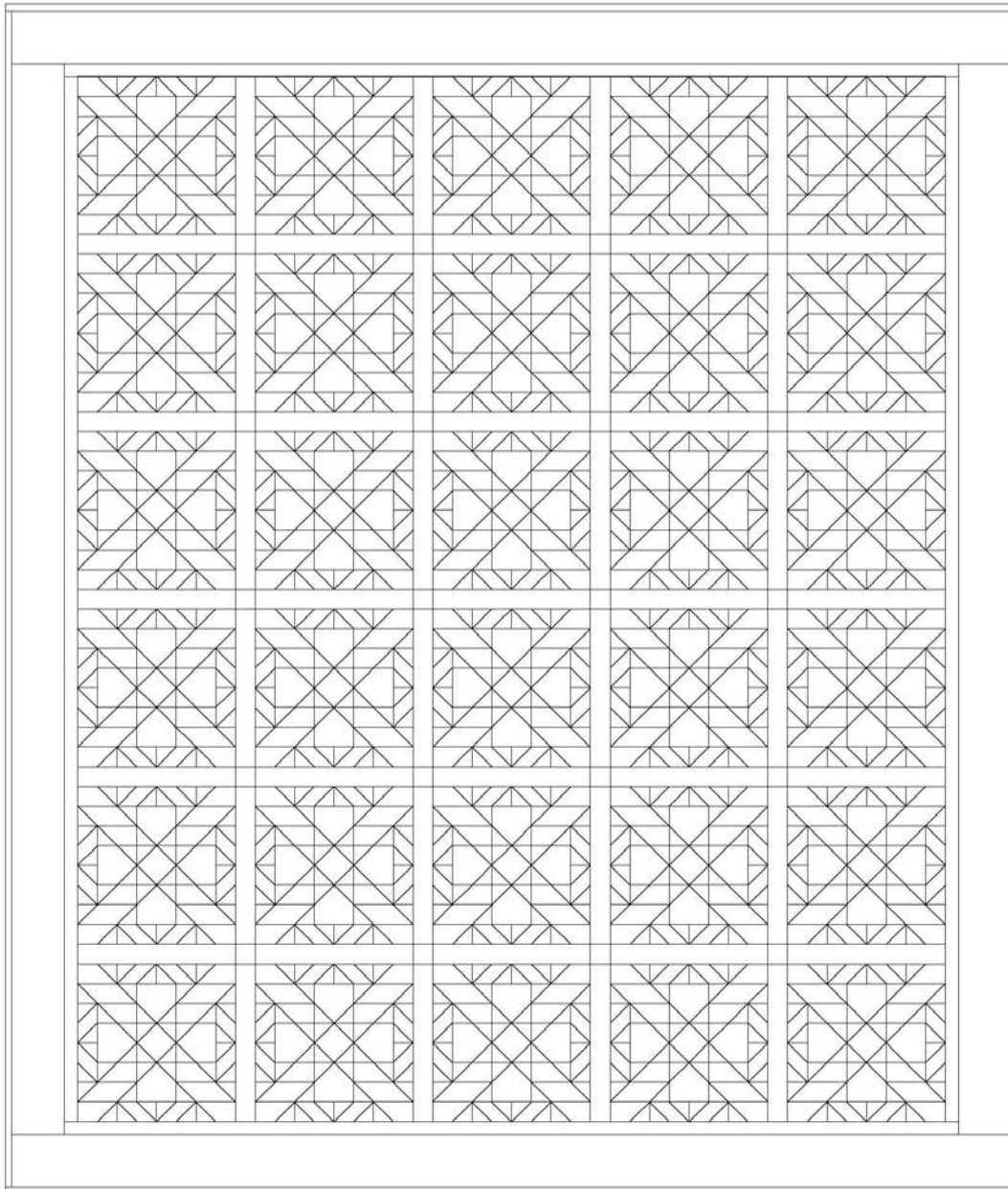
Finishing

18. Create a sandwich with the batting between the quilt top and the backing. Pin or baste layers together, mark quilting design, and quilt by hand or machine. When quilting is complete, remove pins or basting, and trim batting and backing even with raw edges of the quilt top.

19. Join the nine 2-1/2" 9570-76 Jot Dot – Teal binding strips end to end using a diagonal seam to make one long strip. Fold in half lengthwise and press. Sew binding to the edges of the quilt, mitering corners, and overlapping ends. Fold binding to the back of the quilt and stitch it in place by hand to finish.
