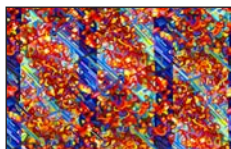

Materials

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

One 2092P-70 Scenic Panel - Lt. Blue
1/4 yard 2088-70 Linear Geometric - Lt. Blue
1/2 yard 9570-22 Jot Dot - Fuchsia
1/2 yard 2089-75 Abstract Circles - Blue
1/2 yard 2088-44 Linear Geometric - Yellow
1/2 yard 2090-55 Abstract Tree Trunks - Purple
5/8 yard 2085-22 Flowers - Pink
2/3 yard 9570-77 Jot Dot - Dk. Blue
2/3 yard 9570-09 Jot Dot - Marshmallow
2-7/8 yards 2084-70 Trees - Lt. Blue for backing
49" x 69" piece of Air Lite® Colour Me
100% Cotton batting
Paper for foundation piecing

Cut Fabrics

Note: *All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise indicated.*

From 2092P-70 Scenic Panel - Lt. Blue:

*Trim panel to 20-1/2" x 40-1/2".

From 2088-70 Linear Geometric - Lt. Blue:

*Cut two 3-1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut twenty-eight 3" x 3-1/4" squares.

From 9570-22 Jot Dot - Fuchsia:

*Cut five 1-1/4" x WOF strips for border 6.
*Cut four 1-1/2" x WOF strips for border 1.

From 2089-75 Abstract Circles - Blue:

*Cut one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut four 2-1/2" squares.
*Cut four 2-1/2" x WOF strips for border 3.

From 2088-44 Linear Geometric - Yellow:

*Cut nine 2" x LOF strips for border 2.

From 2090-55 Abstract Tree Trunks - Purple:

*Cut twelve 2" x LOF strips for border 7.

From 2085-22 Flowers - Pink:

*Cut four 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut fifty-six

3" x 3-1/2" rectangles.

*Cut one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut four 1-3/8" x 5-1/2" strips, four 1-3/8" x 4-5/8" strips, and eight 2-1/2" x 4-1/4" rectangles.

From 9570-77 Jot Dot - Dk. Blue:

*Cut one 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut four 1" x 2-1/2" strips and four 1" x 3" strips.

*Cut four 1" x WOF strips for border 4.

*Cut six 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.

From 9570-09 Jot Dot - Marshmallow:

*Cut one 4-1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut eight 2-1/2" x 4-1/4" rectangles and four 2-1/8" squares.

*Cut four 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut fifty-six 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles.

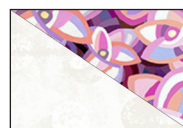
Assemble Blocks

Measurements include 1/4" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated. If no direction is specified, press the seam toward the darker fabric.

1. Trace or print twenty-eight copies of the A template and four copies each of templates B and C. Paper piece each section referring to Table 1 (next page) for fabric placement. Note that you will place the fabrics on the template's backside and stitch the seams on the printed side. Press open, trim, and remove the paper (*figure 1*).

Reflections - Quilt 1

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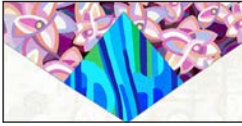

2. Sew one 1" x 2-1/2" 9570-77 Jot Dot - Dk. Blue strip to the left side of one 2-1/2" 2089-75 Abstract Circles – Blue square. Press the seam toward the strip. Repeat to make four units. With the Dk. Blue strip facing left, sew a 1" x 3" 9570-77 Jot Dot - Dk. Blue strip to the top of each unit (*figure 2*). Press as before.

3. Noting fabric orientation, sew a 2-1/8" 9570-09 Jot Dot – Marshmallow square to the left side of the Step 1 C-units (*figure 3*). Press the seams toward the square.

4. Noting fabric orientation, sew a Step 1 B-unit to the left side of the Step 2 units. Press the seams toward the square. Sew the Step 3 units to the top and press the seams open (*figure 4*).

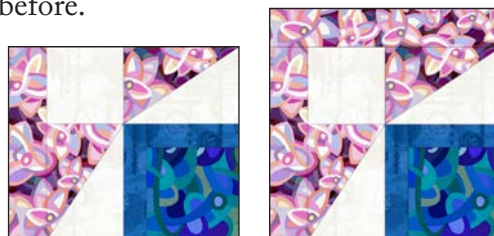


Figure 5 – Make (4) 5-1/2" blocks.

5. Sew a 1-3/8" x 4-5/8" 2085-22 Flowers – Pink strip to the left side of the Step 4 units. Press the seams toward the Pink strip. Sew a 1-3/8" x 5-1/2" Pink strip to the top of all the units to make four 5-1/2" border corner blocks (*figure 5*). Press the seams as before.

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Assemble Quilt Top

6. For border 1, trim two 1-1/2" 9570-22 Jot Dot - Fuchsia strips to 40-1/2" length and sew them to each side of the panel. Press the seams toward the border strips. Trim the remaining Fuchsia strips to 20-1/2" and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Again, press the seams toward the borders.

7. For border 2, join two 2" 2088-44 Linear Geometric - Yellow border strips (cut on the LOF) end to end using diagonal seams. Trim them to 25-1/2" length and set them aside. Sew together the remaining 2" Yellow strips, cut two 45-1/2" lengths, and sew one strip to each side of the quilt. Press the seams toward the borders. Finally, sew one 25-1/2" strip to the top and one to the bottom. Press as before.

8. Borders 3, 4, and 5 will be stitched together in sets and then sewn to the quilt. Sew together the 2-1/2" 2089-75 Abstract Circles - Blue strips end to end using diagonal seams. Cut two 45-1/2" lengths and set aside. Repeat with the 1" 9570-77 Jot Dot - Dk. Blue strips. Sew a Dk. Blue long strip to a Circles - Blue strip. Repeat to make another strip set.

9. Sew together nine Step 1 A units. Repeat to make another row. Press the seams open. Noting fabric orientation, sew one row to each of the Blue strip sets above. Press the seams toward the strips. Sew one border set to each side of the quilt center and press the seams away from the center.

10. From the remaining Dk. Blue/Circles - Blue strips, cut two 25-1/2" lengths. Sew them together into two sets as you did on Step 7. Join five Step 1 A units into a row as on Step 9. Repeat to make another row. Sew one row to each of the Dk. Blue/Circles - Blue sets.

11. Noting fabric orientation, sew one Step 5 corner block to each end of the Step 10 border sets and press the seams away from the center. Next, sew one border to the top and one to the bottom of the quilt top. Press the seams toward the center.

12. For border 6, sew the five 1-1/4" 9570-22 Jot Dot - Fuchsia border strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and cut two border strips that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut two border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.

13. Repeat Step 12 with the twelve 2" 2090-55 Abstract Tree Trunks - Purple strips (cut on the LOF) to make and add border 7.

Finishing

14. Create a quilt sandwich with the batting between the quilt top and the backing. Pin or baste layers together, mark quilting design, and quilt by hand or machine. When quilting is complete, remove pins or basting, and trim batting and backing even with raw edges of the quilt top.

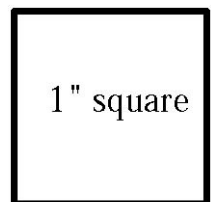
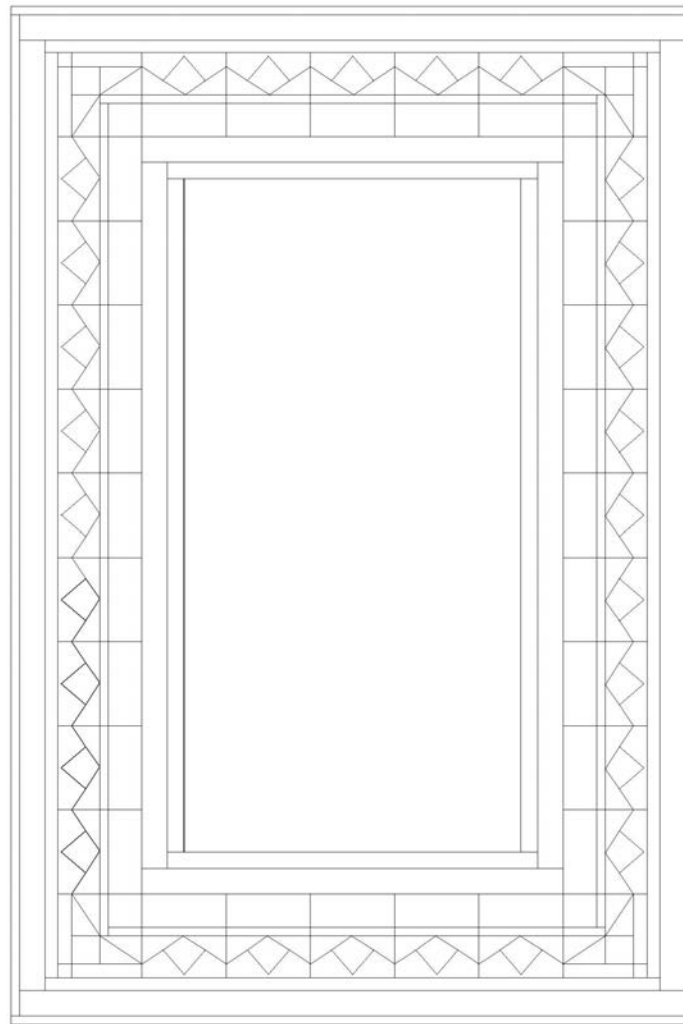
15. Join the six 2-1/2" 9570-77 Jot Dot - Dk. Blue binding strips together end to end using a diagonal seam to make one long strip. Fold in half lengthwise and press. Sew binding to the edges of the quilt, mitering corners, and overlapping ends. Fold binding to the back of the quilt and stitch it in place by hand to finish.
