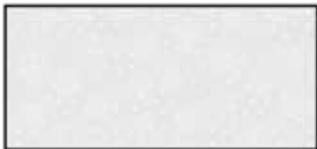

Wall Hanging Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Leprechaun Hats - Light Green (A), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 ½" squares.

From the Jot Dot - Black (B), cut:

- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 1 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 24 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 26 ½" WOF strips.
- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the St. Pat's Day Plaid - Green (C), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ⅞" squares.
- (2) 3 ½" x 26 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 3 ½" x 32 ½" WOF strips.

From the Starlet - White (D), cut:

- (2) 8 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (5) 8 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ⅞" squares.
- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 1 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the St. Pat's Day Words - Light Green (E), cut:

- See instructions to cut (1) Large Clover.

From the Clovers - Light Green (F), cut:

- See instructions to cut (4) Large Clovers.

From the St. Pat's Day Wreaths - White (Backing), cut:

- (1) 40" x 40" WOF strip for the backing.

Wall Hanging Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
2. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
3. Refer to Figure 1 to arrange and press (1) Fabric F Large Clover onto (1) 8 ½" Fabric D square.
4. Finish the raw edges of the clover with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Block One square.
5. Repeat Steps 3-4 to make (4) Block One squares total.
6. Repeat Steps 3-4 and refer to Figure 2 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (1) Block Two square.

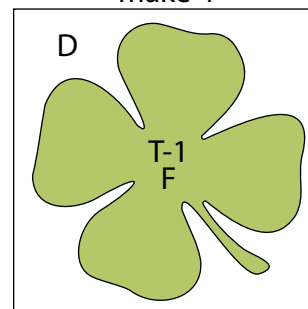

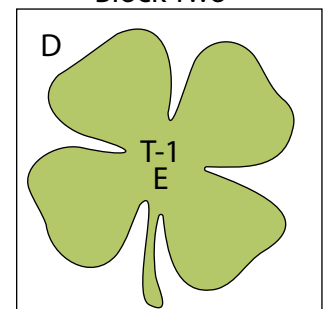

7. Place (1) 2 ⅞" Fabric C square on top of (1) 2 ⅞" Fabric D square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 3). Sew ¼" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 3). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 4) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2 ½" square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (16) Unit 1 squares total.

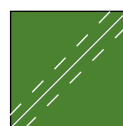

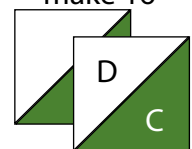

Table Set

8. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric D strip to the top of (1) 1 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric B strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (16) Unit 2 strips total.

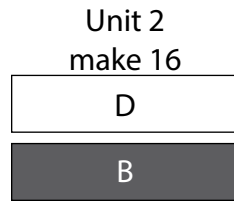

9. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each end of (1) Unit 2 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to each side of (1) 4 ½" Fabric A square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 8 ½" Block Three square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (4) Block Three squares total.

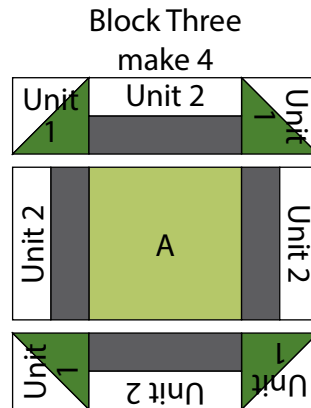

10. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Three square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Block Three square to each side of the Block Two square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make the 24 ½" x 24 ½" Wall Hanging Center Block (Fig. 8).

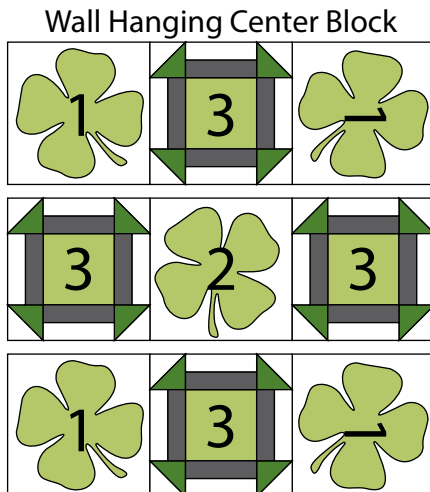

Wall Hanging Assembly Instructions

(Follow the Wall Hanging Layout in Figure 9 while assembling the wall hanging top.)

11. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 24 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 26 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

12. Sew (12) 3 ½" x 26 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 32 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

13. Layer and quilt as desired.

14. Sew the (4) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

15. Bind as desired.

Wall Hanging Quilt Layout

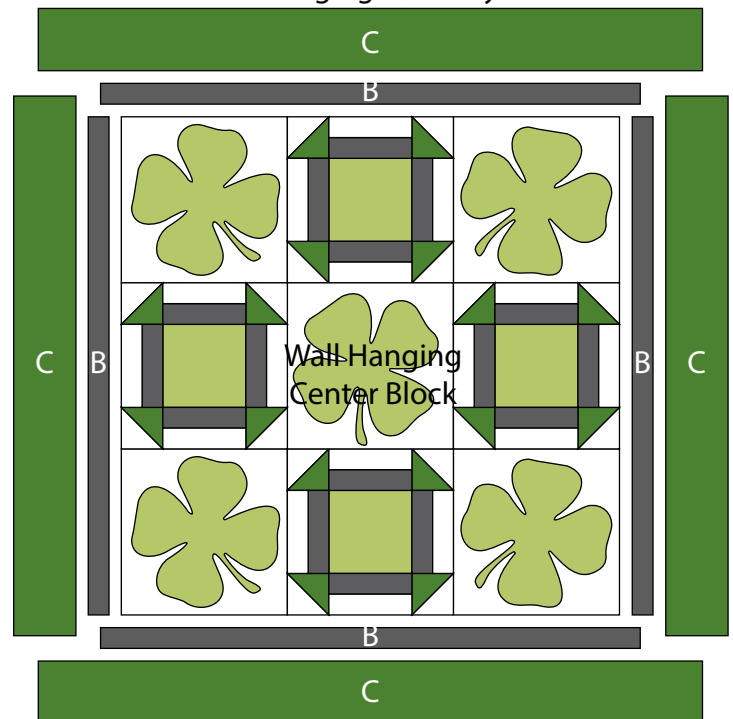

Place Mat Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Leprechaun Hats - Light Green (A), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3 ½" squares.

From the Jot Dot - Black (B), cut:

- (3) 1 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 1 ¼" x 3 ½" strips.

From the St. Pat's Day Plaid - Green (C), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅜" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ⅜" squares.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 12 ½" strips.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Starlet - White (D), cut:

- (2) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 6 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 ⅜" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ⅜" squares.
- (3) 1 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 1 ¼" x 3 ½" strips.

From the St. Pat's Day Words - Light Green (E), cut:

- See instructions to cut (4) Small Clovers.

From the Clovers - Light Green (F), cut:

- See instructions to cut (4) Small Clovers.

From the St. Pat's Day Wreaths - White (Backs), cut:

- (2) 16" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 16" x 20" rectangles for the backs.

Place Mat Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

- Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
- Refer to Figure 10 to arrange and press (1) Fabric F Small Clover onto (1) 6 ½" Fabric D square.
- Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Block Four square.
- Repeat Steps 18-19 to make (4) Block Four squares total.
- Repeat Steps 18-19 and refer to Figure 11 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (4) Block Five squares.

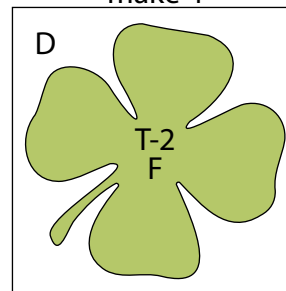

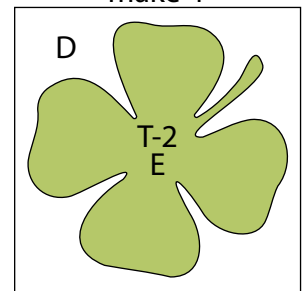

- Place (1) 2 ⅜" Fabric C square on top of (1) 2 ⅜" Fabric D square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 12). Sew ¼" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 12). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 13) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2" square to make (2) Unit 3 squares (Fig. 14). Repeat to make (32) Unit 3 squares total.

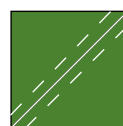

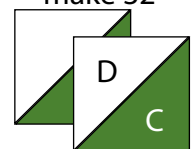

Table Set

23. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top of (1) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 4 strip (Fig. 15). Repeat to make (32) Unit 4 strips total.

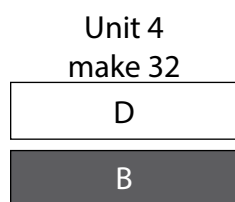

24. Sew (1) Unit 3 square to each end of (1) Unit 4 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 4 strip to each side of (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square to make the middle row. Sew together (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Six square (Fig. 16). Repeat to make (8) Block Six squares total.

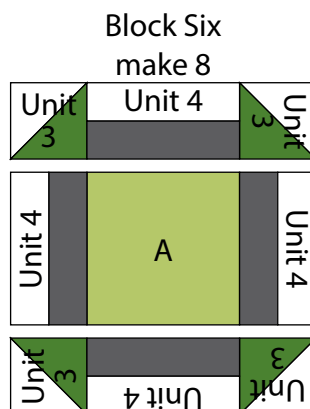

25. Sew (1) Block Six square to the left side of (1) Block Four square to make the top row. Sew (1) Block Five square to the left side of (1) Block Six square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 5 square (Fig. 17). Repeat to make (4) Unit 5 squares total.

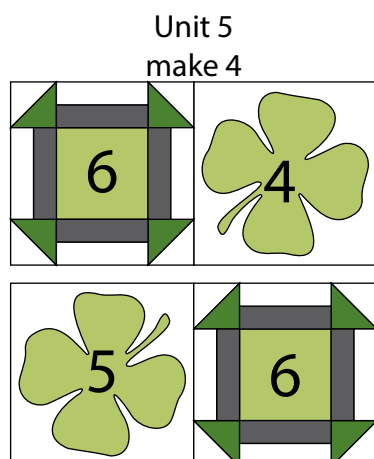

Place Mat Assembly Instructions

(Follow the Place Mat Layout in Figure 18 while assembling the place mat tops.)

26. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 5 square to make (1) $16\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Place Mat top (Fig. 18). Repeat to make (4) Place Mat tops total.

27. Layer and quilt as desired.

28. Sew the (7) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Cut the strip into (4) equal lengths.

29. Bind as desired.

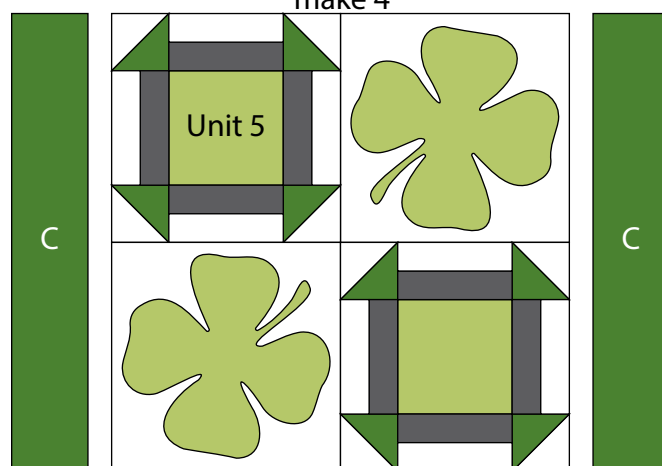

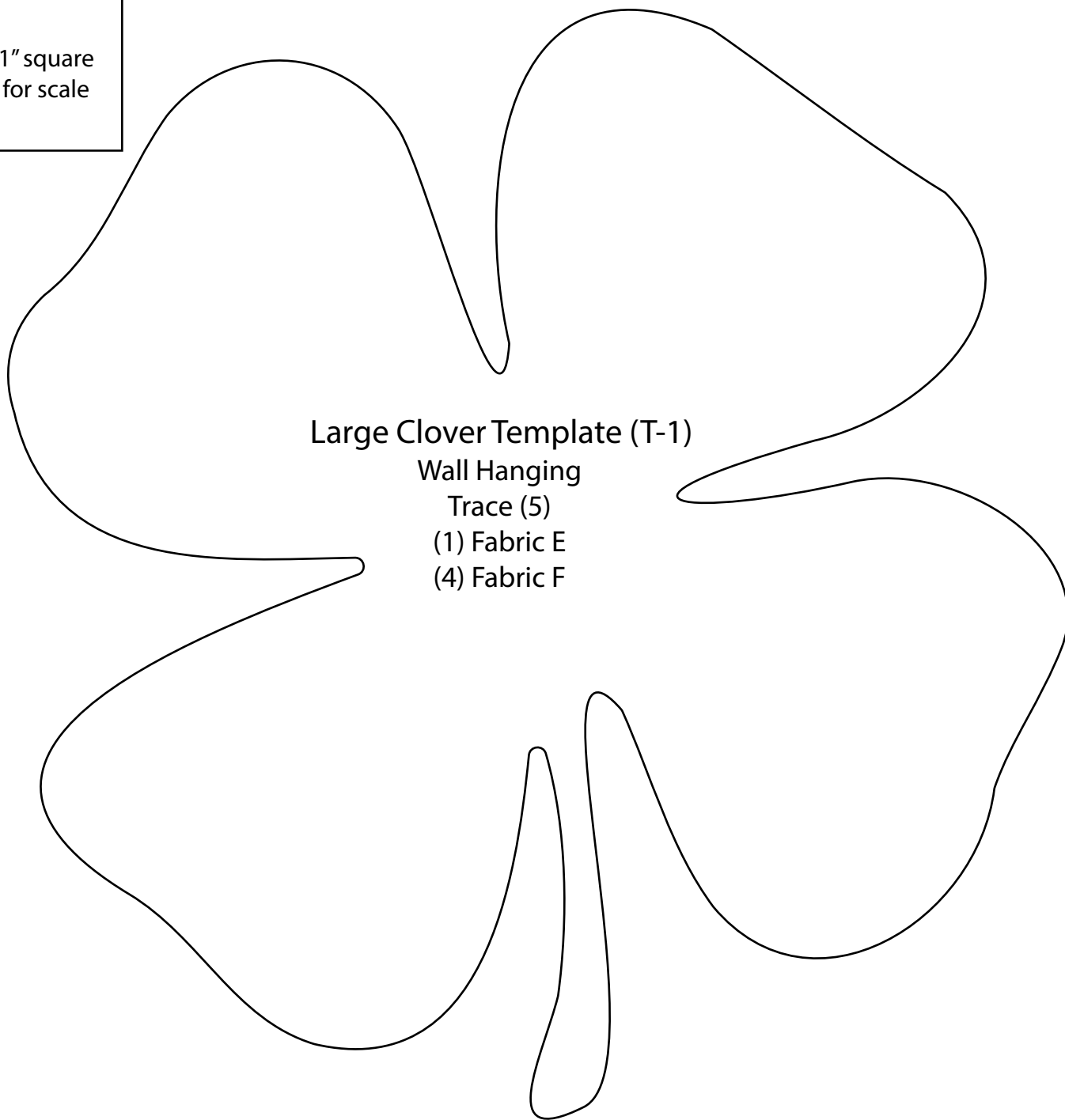
Large Clover Template (T-1)

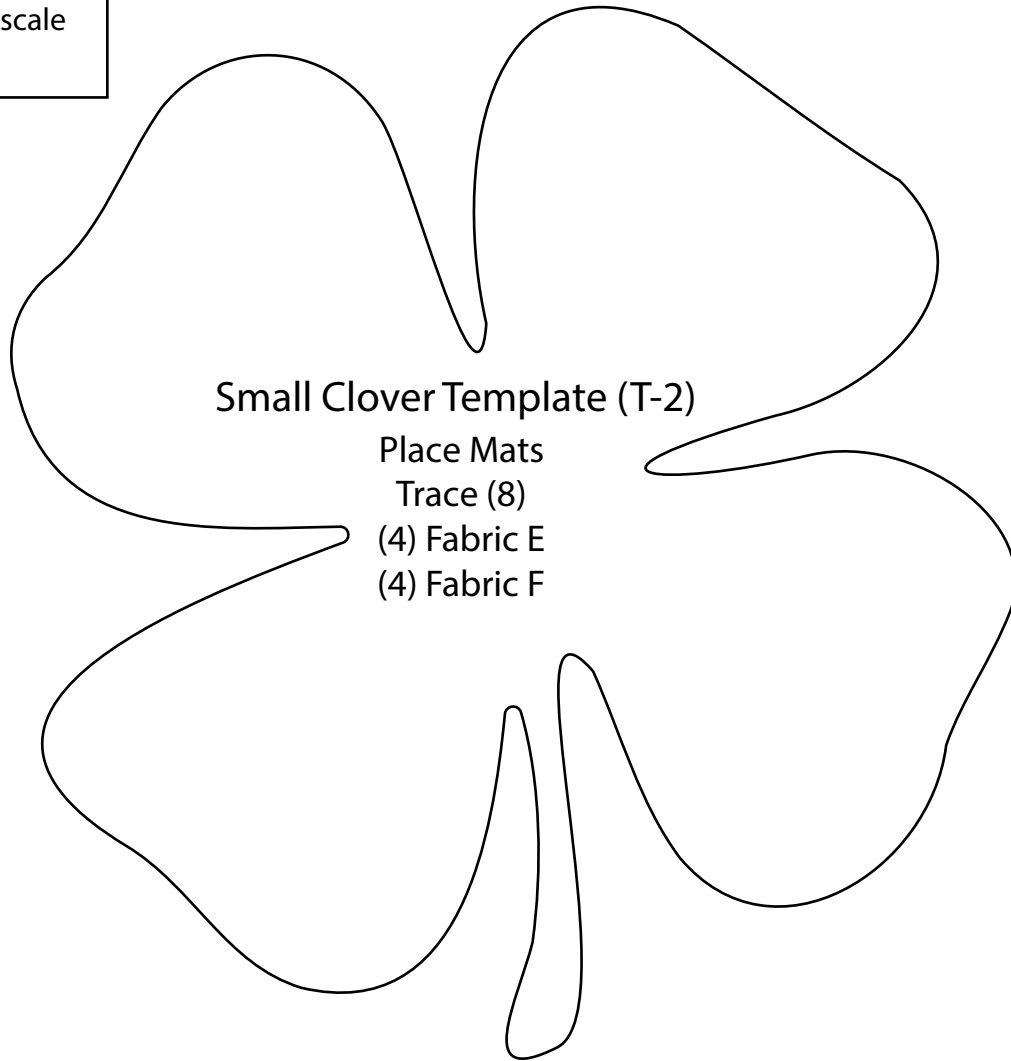
